

**HEALTHCARE WORKER – COLORADO - COVID VACCINE RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION REQUEST FORM**

The Colorado State Board of Health approved a rule on August 30, 2021, which requires COVID19 vaccination for staff in certain licensed healthcare facilities. This rule affects specific licensed healthcare facilities, including all hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers. The rule indicates that all HealthONE employees, direct contractors and support staff working in these facilities must get the COVID-19 vaccine, unless they have submitted and been approved for a valid, documented medical or religious exemption. All required individuals, no later than **October 31, 2021** must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 unless an exemption has been approved. Failure to become vaccinated or secure an exemption will impact your ability to work after the State’s October 31 deadline.

As required by the rule, as well as state and federal law, reasonable accommodations will be provided to colleagues who have a medical condition or religious belief which prohibits them from receiving COVID-19 vaccination. Any colleague wishing to request an accommodation, and therefore an exemption for the vaccine mandate, must complete this form and submit it to your VPro Account [www.hwsverified.com](http://www.hwsverified.com)
