## Interventional Breast Procedure Biopsy Aide:

The Interventional Breast Procedure Biopsy Aide must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.

#### Definition of Care or Service:

The Interventional Breast Procedure Biopsy Aide assists biopsy technologists and radiologists with interventional breast procedures and is responsible for procedural supplies. Scope of service includes:

- Assist with preparation of procedure trays and biopsy equipment.
- Assists with patient post procedure care including holding pressure on biopsy sites following the procedures. Explain post biopsy care instructions to patients and completed the required paperwork.
- Clean and sanitize biopsy rooms following procedures. Straighten biopsy rooms and change linen.
- Sorts supplies and ensures all biopsy rooms are stocked with necessary supplies and equipment.
- Tracks and orders all supplies through the Material Management department
- Required to respond to medical emergency including administering CPR.
- Assists patients with positioning on exam table and may be required to assist patients to prevent falls.
- Dispose of hazardous waste and sharps as needed
- Order and cancel any Nuclear Medicine isotope dosage as needed.
- Make pre-op calls to patients 2 days prior to exams
- Organize to paperwork for radiologist review for all patients for next business day
- Enter all patients name and information into the required post-op log book for patient records
- Completes other duties as assigned.
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

#### Setting(s):

• Healthcare facilities including but not limited to hospitals, outpatient treatment facilities, imaging centers, and physician practices.

- General guidance and direction by the Radiology Director and supervisor.
- Supervision is defined by any limitations in practice that may be addressed by state law.
