Interventional Nurse:

The Interventional Nurse must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.

Definition of Care or Service:

The Interventional Nurse assists physicians at clinic location with consultations, follow-up appointments and scheduling hospital procedures. Assists with patient assessments and reviews clinical charts and serves as a liaison between the patient and radiologist. Scope of service includes:

- Obtains medical histories and answers patient questions and concerns
- Performs physical examinations
- Required to respond to medical emergency including administering CPR.
- Assists patients with positioning on exam table and may be required to assist patients to prevent falls.
- Schedules procedures for clinic patients to be performed at the hospital by the interventional radiologists and informs patient of pre-procedure requirements
- Completes follow-up calls to patient post procedure and schedules two week follow-up visit
- Triages phone calls from patients and follows up as necessary
- Acts as a resource for Patient Care Coordinators and Medical Assistants in order to facilitate patient care in a safe and timely manner
- Treats all patients with compassionate care and provides a welcoming environment
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians

• Healthcare facilities including but not limited to hospitals and outpatient imaging centers

Supervision:

Direct supervision by privileged radiologist

Evaluator: Privileged radiologist with input from the Radiology Director and/or Radiation Safety Officer

The Intervention RN will demonstrate:

- Perform physical exam
- Safe environment for patients
 - Uses at least two ways to identify patients before providing acupuncture
 - o Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible
- Accurate patient information review and evaluation
 - o Collects and documents assessment data in the medical record
 - o Facilitates communication between the radiologist, patient, family and nursing staff
 - o Educates patients and their family about the medical treatment plan and discharge plans
 - Notifies the appropriate member of the interdisciplinary patient care team of issues that require immediate intervention or attention
- Infection Prevention
 - o Practices consistent hand hygiene
 - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) when required
 - o Required immunizations per Division requirements
 - Complies with Isolation precautions
 - Maintains sterile field
