## **Applicant Name:**

#### **Bariatric Nurse:**

The Bariatric Nurse must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.

#### **Definition of Care or Service:**

The Bariatric Nurse deals with the causes, prevention and treatment of obesity.

Scope of service may include:

- Provides patient teaching, evaluates patient progress after bariatric surgery and alters plan if needed
- Prepares patients for discharge in collaboration with the bariatric surgery team.
- Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA Healthcare conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

- Surgical services areas including but not limited to hospitals and outpatient surgery centers
- Healthcare facilities including but not limited to hospitals, outpatient treatment facilities, imaging centers,

• Indirect supervision by physician or other licensed independent practitioner

## Competencies:

The Bariatric Nurse will demonstrate:

- Safe and effective operation of any equipment
  - Maintains equipment in good working order
  - o Demonstrates effective infection control practices related to equipment operation
- Accurate patient information review and evaluation



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- $\circ$  Uses at least two ways (name and date of birth) to identify patients before providing care
- Accesses the patient's medical record appropriately if access is approved by the facility
- Documents in the medical record according to the facility standard/policy
- Provides patient care
- Performs patient assessment and reassessment
- Participates in care planning/coordination
- Provides patient and family education
- Infection Prevention
  - Practices consistent hand hygiene
  - Uses personal protective equipment (PPE) when required
  - Required immunizations per Division requirements
  - Complies with Isolation precautions
  - Maintains sterile field
