<p>Certified Athletic Trainer (Pre-Operative, PACU, And Operating Room) : The Certified Athletic Trainer (Pre-Operative, PACU, and Operating Room) must have equivalent qualifications, competence and function in the same role as employed individuals performing the same or similar services at the facility, as defined by facility job description.</p>
<p>Definition of Care or Service: The Certified Athletic Trainer (Pre-Operative, PACU, and Operating Room) collaborates with physicians to provide pre-operative and post-operative patient education with regard to an exercise program. The athletic trainer also collaborates with the employer physician to provide assistance with patient positioning as well as limited and further defined surgical technologist’s tasking’s. Scope of service may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist in patient mobility • Recognize and evaluate injuries • Responsible for aiding physicians in procedures as needed (ex. retraction of tissues) • Plan and implement comprehensive programs to prevent injury and illness which include education documents • Apply protective or injury-preventative devices such as tape, bandages/dressings, splints, braces, and slings • Perform administrative tasks, such as keeping records and writing reports on injuries and treatment programs • Demonstrates Clinical and Service excellence behaviors to include code of HCA conduct core fundamentals in daily interactions with patients, families, co-workers and physicians.

- Participates in the pre-procedure process to verify the correct procedure, for the correct patient, at the correct site and involves the patient in the verification process when possible

 - Documents in the medical record according to the facility standard/policy
 - Uses Performance Improvement Plan to improve patient safety
