Reiki Practitioner:

The reiki Practitioner provides Reiki services to enhance the body's natural ability to heal itself to Hospital patients and employees on request. Reiki services include administering Reiki energy through standardized hand placements either on or directly over the patient and after asking permission to touch.

Definition of Care or Service:

The Reiki Practitioner:

- Interacts with the staff, patients, and public with dignity and respect; behavior is courteous and professional, reflecting sensitivity to the hospital's values and to the Ethic and Compliance principles.
- Identifies cultural and religious needs, language barriers, etc. and modifies Reiki techniques to accommodate these needs.
- Verbalizes the process for resolution of ethical dilemmas.
- Adheres to hospital policy for reporting patient safety issues. Including errors. Consistently puts "Patients Safety First" when providing job duties or providing care.
- Demonstrates knowledge of social development and health needs of patients/employees.
- Recognizes and reports signs and symptoms of abuse.
- Demonstrates attention to physical, psychosocial, spiritual, and educational needs of patients/employees and communicates concerns with staff RN.
- Gathers information from patient's medical record and patient and family as indicated.
- Reviews functional limitations and adjust Reiki to accommodate individual needs.
- Demonstrates knowledge of the pain scale.
- Demonstrates knowledge of the ability to apply the prior Reiki hand positions routinely used in healthcare settings.
 - I. On the forehead, over the eyes, but not touching them
 - II. On the temples
 - III. On the crown
 - IV. On the top of the shoulders
 - V. On the ankles
 - VI. On the feet
- Obtains consent from the patient/employee before treating.
- Provides patient employee privacy.
- Knows contraindications to Reiki
- Verbalizes own role in a code blue
- Communicates effectively with patients/employees of varying developmental levels.
- Explains Reiki as a relaxation and stress reduction technique in the hospital setting.
- Interacts with hospital staff to provide comprehensive care.
- Verbalizes understanding of the department's organizational performance improvement goals.
- Documents patient/employee response to Reiki
- Assist with compiling monthly statistics.



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- Assists with maintaining Reiki records
- Works with Reiki coordinator in regards to personnel concerns.
